






Good for you and good for the environment: sustainably manufactured vinyl floorings

Low-emission – the best indoor air

Healthy materials are an absolute priority, given that we spend 80–90% of our life in closed rooms and breathe in the air indoors. Today's virtually air-proof buildings minimise the exchange of air to such an extent that toxins from the different materials and furnishings can build up in a room. EXPONA floors are labelled with the Indoor Air Comfort Gold seal, which is only awarded to products that stay within strict VOC emission levels and therefore guarantee the best quality of indoor air.

Hygienic – healthy homes

Floorings can have a significant impact on the health of a building's occupants by being easy to clean, not allowing germs and bacteria to become established and preventing mould from developing when the flooring gets damp. EXPONA floorings are hygienic, waterproof and highly recommended for allergy and asthma sufferers.

Odour-neutral – relaxation for the senses

Odours that are emitted by construction materials or furniture are perceived to be very annoying by the building's occupants, who consider these to have a significant negative impact on their well-being. EXPONA floorings are odour-neutral right from the outset. In other words, rooms can be used as soon as the flooring has been laid.

Soft and warm underfoot – a welcoming floor experience

People want to feel 100% relaxed at home, walking around barefoot or in socks. EXPONA flooring is made with this in mind: it doesn't get statically charged and is comfortingly warm and soft underfoot. A wonderful feeling – with shoes or without.

This entails a responsible approach to obtaining raw materials and ensuring the recyclability of our floorings. Many years ago, as a member of the AGPU (a German working group focussed on PVC and the environment), we invested heavily in establishing a successful nationwide system for recycling and recovering raw materials.

- Our manufacturing plants are certified as compliant with the strict international standards BES 6001 and SA 8000, as well as with the environmental management standard ISO 14001, which confirms our commitment to environmentally responsible procurement, alongside many other aspects.
- Our floorings comply with the AgBB scheme for evaluating the health impacts of emissions from building materials.

Saving water and cleaning agents – for the love of the environment

All EXPONA floorings have been coated with the CleanShield™ surface treatment. Our unique, cross-linked and UV-hardened PUR surface treatment protects the flooring over the long term, making it extremely hard-wearing and low-maintenance.

Dirt adhesion is significantly reduced. Regular vacuuming or sweeping is usually all that the floor needs. More stubborn dirt can be removed with a mop, using a minimum amount of water and a conventional neutral cleaning agent or PU (polyurethane) cleaner.


Durable – no need to pre-polish

- All EXPONA floorings have been certified according to the Green Guide to Specification and awarded the top rating of A+. This guide is the oldest and most internationally widespread evaluation system for sustainable construction materials, released by the independent organisation BRE Global.
- An independent inspector from the Institut Bauen und Umwelt e.V. (IBU) inspects our environmental product declarations (EPD) for compliance with ISO 14025 and EN 14804. These inspections cover the entire life cycle of the products from procurement of the raw materials to their disposal.
- As a provider of LVT floorings, we have been awarded the DGNB Navigator Label from the German Society for Sustainable Construction. To ensure that customers have quick and easy access to all key information regarding sustainable construction, all products in the collection are listed in the DGBN Navigator with the corresponding EPD.

Cost savings – a long-term benefit

The quality of EXPONA floorings and the special CleanShield™ surface treatment — which makes flooring easy to clean with a minimum of water, energy and cleaning agent — both pay off for you too. The maintenance costs of EXPONA floorings are approx. 30% lower than other flooring materials. This is a significant saving, because the maintenance costs of floorings over a 10-year period represent around 90% of the total costs of the floor — and EXPONA floorings usually last twice as long as other floorings.

What is vinyl, and what is LVT (luxury vinyl tile) flooring?

The main component of vinyl flooring is polyvinyl chloride (PVC). This material is also used for manufacturing products such as life-saving medicines, children's toys, shoes and food packaging. When subject to specific processing techniques, polyvinyl chloride presents the optimum characteristics for use in flooring, since it is low-maintenance, robust, resistant to damp and durable. This is why LVT flooring has proved its worth for a good number of decades in buildings such as shops, hospitals and restaurants.



What are the benefits of vinyl flooring, particularly for the home?

Over the last 25 years, we have developed, optimised and perfected our printing and embossing techniques to such an extent that our wood and stone designs look deceptively real and have an authentic textured finish, making it incredibly difficult to tell them apart from their natural counterparts. This explains how we became the leading supplier of healthy vinyl floorings for homes. Since then, EXPONA floorings have become particularly popular for both residential and commercial properties. They are as beautiful as wood, yet are waterproof and low-maintenance, too. They are as attractive as ceramic, yet are comfortingly warm underfoot. EXPONA can be installed in any room — including the lounge, kitchen and bathroom — ensuring a consistent, harmonious floor design throughout the house. Even more exclusivity: the dimensions of the planks and tiles allow the designs to be installed in a wide range of patterns, or combined with different feature strips and grouting strips. Our collection also comprises unique, striking designs — for example, graphic patterns.



What is the composition of EXPONA vinyl flooring?

Due to their minimal installation height, the vinyl floorings are also perfect for renovations. Old tiles do not need to be chiselled out – the vinyl flooring can be laid directly on top of a professionally primed tiled floor. There is no need to plane doors down, either.


What are plasticisers?

Because vinyl or PVC is a hard plastic, it needs to be made soft and flexible before it can be used as flooring. The substances that give vinyl the necessary malleability, dimensional stability and flexibility are known as 'plasticisers'. There are many different types of plasticiser. They are strictly tested to ensure that they are harmless for our health and either approved – or forbidden – for specific applications by the EU Commission. For example, the EU has forbidden the use of lower-molecular-weight (or short-chain) phthalates in certain areas, such as children's toys. Many years of research and the development of improved formulas have enabled the emergence of safer and non-hazardous plasticisers. EU risk assessments carried out by leading scientific experts from EU member states have shown that modern high-molecular-weight, long-chain plasticisers can be safely used in vinyl flooring without endangering either human health or – as they are biodegradable – the environment. EXPONA floorings are manufactured exclusively using non-hazardous, organic and phthalate-free plasticisers.



Which other products contain the same plasticisers that are used in EXPONA flooring?

The organic, phthalate-free plasticisers that we use are also used in strictly controlled fields, such as medicines, toys and products designed for food contact.







Is formaldehyde used for the manufacture of vinyl flooring?

No. Formaldehyde can be found in certain construction materials, floorings (e.g. ready-to-use parquet and laminate flooring) and furniture. Because formaldehyde has been declared as a carcinogenic substance, its concentration indoors is not allowed to exceed a certain recommended threshold. Our vinyl flooring is manufactured strictly without any formaldehyde.



What impact does vinyl have on valuable resources?

With a petroleum content of 43%, vinyl only contains a small amount of non-renewable resources, compared to other products. Petroleum can be found in almost all items that we use on a daily basis, such as toothbrushes, shower products, ballpoint pens and medicines. Chloride, which makes up almost 57% of vinyl, is derived – like the majority of the salt that we eat – from rock salt, which is available in large, virtually infinite, supply. We refrain from using any type of wood as a raw material at all – in fact, wood never even enters our manufacturing process.

Modern manufacturing processes mean that vinyl has a low environmental impact. Because the material can be processed at low temperatures, the energy required for manufacturing is relatively low compared to other materials such as metal, glass and ceramics. Other benefits include durability, low-maintenance properties and good recyclability.
